Swan Hills Be Active Club Challenge

Sunday 3rd of July, 2005 saw the running of Swan Hills first Interclub. With only five members competing it was always going to be hard to finish amongst the top point scoring clubs, not withstanding all five members put in sterling efforts, even managing to win their age group in both relay events.

Eighty three swimmers nominated with seventy actually competing on the day. Twelve individual and six relay State records and one individual and seven relay National records fell to competing swimmers.

One of our newest members Graeme Groom surprised himself with some very decent times, one of these being fast enough to snare himself a State record in the 100m Backstroke (1m29.69s), not to be outdone, Sandra Smith set two personal best times along with a State record for the 100m Backstroke (1m40.48s). Super fast Stefan Kohler, was not beaten on the day and set State records in the 50m Free (27.53s) and 50m Butterfly (29.62s). It was good to see Erin Shaw competing and Trish Deaker was very pleased with her times, especially for her 50m Breaststroke.

Be Active Club Challenge Saturday July 23 Margaret River Aquatic Centre

Swim and socialize at one of the few Saturday events on the Masters swimming program. Swim hard on Saturday, party hard on Saturday night, recover on Sunday.

Warm up from 12 noon for a 12.30 start. Cost \$5 per person includes pool entry.

Because you don't get much chance to swim short course (25m pool) events, we try to give you plenty of choice, but we do need to restrict the program in the interests of finishing on time.

Events are 200m, 100m, 50m and 25m of all strokes including 200m IM and 100m IM. Swimmers are restricted to three events per person, including only one 200m and one 100m event.

Keep Saturday night free from 7pm for a Christmas-in-July dinner at the Margaret River Cultural Centre (adjacent to the pool), with DJ and dancing. Cost \$25 per person (partners welcome) for a two-course meal, cash bar available at very good prices.

Entries close on Friday July 15. Please give entries to your club secretary, along with money for both the swim and dinner.
